Priority Leisure Access Card Application Form

We are delighted to announce the launch of the Priority Leisure Access scheme in Allerdale Borough. The card enables those who qualify through the scheme to benefit from a 50% discount on standard pay per visit prices at Workington, Cockermouth and Keswick leisure facilities and at our other facilities in and around Carlisle.

What is included?

It's easier to list the activities that aren't! All pay as you play activities are included so you can use your priority card at all of the gyms, pools, exercise classes, most sports, golf, tennis and much more.

NB: Courses, lessons, sunbeds and certain children's/holiday activities are not included and some booking and authorisation conditions may apply – please check with each centre. Block bookings and hall hires not included.

Who is eligible?

Priority leisure Access cards are available to all adults and children up to 16 years of age currently resident in the Borough (N.B. A resident is defined as a person paying Council Tax to Allerdale Borough Council).

Do I qualify for priority status?

You qualify for priority status if you fall into one of the following categories:

Students (including student nurses): Must be full time and aged over 16 and have either an NUS Card or an appropriate stamp from school or college.

Senior Citizens Over 60: Birth Certificate, Pension Book or Bus Pass.

Benefit Recipients: Job seekers allowance, income support, registered disabled, incapacity benefit, government training schemes, housing benefits. Partners will only qualify if they are un-waged.

How do I get one?

It couldn't be easier. Simply fill in this application form and bring it down to your local centre and we will process your application. It will take around a week to make your card which will be posted to your home address.

What do I need to bring? - Bring yourself, The £4.00 fee, two passport sized photographs and we will also need proof of your priority status.

How long does the card last? - The card once produced is valid for 12 months or whenever your priority status ceases which ever comes first. If your priority qualification does end you are obliged to inform us immediately. We also reserve the right to request on the spot proof of qualification and to withdraw the card, both at our discretion.

Renewing the card? - Simply bring along the card to any of the Allerdale facilities above with a £2.00 renewal fee and proof of priority status. We do not send out reminders on expiry.
